

Paleoseismological study of the Sekiya fault in Tochigi Prefecture

The Sekiya fault is an N-S trending thrust in the northern part of Tochigi Prefecture. We surveyed detailed geographical features and opened three trenches on northern part of the fault. The results of these studies show that the last event occurred after 6th century and penultimate event occurred between 20ka and 6th century.
