Remote sounding of meteorological processes in the Japanese Venus orbiter mission

In the Japanese Venus orbiter mission, the spacecraft will be equipped with five multi-channel cameras for meteorological study as well as other instruments for monitoring the plasma environment. These cameras will cover wavelengths from infrared to ultraviolet to construct a three-dimensional view of the thick Venus atmosphere. We will report the latest change of observation plan and the prospect of cooperation with foreign investigators.
