## The Near-infrared Observation of Venus Lower Atmosphere at Gunma Astronomical Observatory.

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We report the near-infrared observation of Venus nightside cooperative with Gunma Astronomical Observatory.

The Galileo NIMS cleared that Venus has several 'windows' in near-infrared region.(Carlson et al.1991) With this 'windows', we can observe Its lower atmosphere

that we can't with visible because of its dense H2SO4 clouds. In this study, we use 1.0,1.7,2.3 um windows to tracking the lower clouds.

The method is the scan mapping with a slit in the spectroscopy mode. Operating telescope in the tracking mode for fixed star, the slit deviates from Venus

because of its revolution. With this method, we can obtain a slit scan data of Venusian nightside for 6 minutes. As a result we can get latitudinal ,specral, and additionally longitudinal informations.
