

A survey of how high school students in Saitama and Kobe feel about earthquakes.

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We made survey about how high school students feel about earthquakes. The survey were carried out at Sakae-Higashi High School in Saitama City and at Suma-Tomogaoka High School in Kobe City. The results of the survey at Sakae-Higashi High School are as follows.

Q: Can you explain about the difference of Intensity Scale from Magnitude?

A: Possible to explain exactly: 14%

Know a little: 52%

Heard the word, but not be able to explain: 34%

Have the least knowledge: 0%

Q: How do you consider a counterplan for earthquake?

A: Confirm a place of safety: 59%

Consider no counterplan: 29%

Q: When do you think great earthquake occur in Tokyo?

A: Until 2005: 34%

Not occur during life: 23%

Q: Do you think prediction information is published before great earthquake occurs in the Tokai area?

A: Yes: 21%

No: 79%
