Temporal change of distance between two trig stations near Hamanako

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Geographical Survey Institute (GSI) repeatedly measured distance between triangulation stations Uwanomi-shinden and Tomimaki-yama. Recently, we checked its rate with GPS campaign data and found it can be interpolated and extrapolated with data obtained at near-by GEONET stations.

Temporal variation of the distance between Uwanomi-shinden and Tomimaki-yama. shows quite similar pattern in 1978-1988 and 1994-2005. The change is not cumulative as is frequently seen. It is easy to understand that decreased distance may recover partly due to slow slip. Large recovery may need another explanation.
