Absolute Gravity Measurement at Kamioka, Gifu, Japan

In July 2005, absolute gravity measurement has been carried out at Kamioka mine, Gifu, Japan. A 100m laser strainmeter system and a superconducting gravimeter were installed in a deep tunnel 1000m below the ground surface. Determined absolute gravity value and calibration of superconducting gravimeter will be reported.
