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## Small earthquakes occurring near the Fukui Earthquake Fault

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Hokuriku Earthquake Observatory has been working after 1974. And from 1976, a telemeter observation system had been set for 7 micro-stations. After Oct. 1997, Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA) started the 'Ichigenka' started to observe earthquakes by a dense station distribution. We use use 122 station data from these to determine the small aftershocks near and around the Fukui earthquake(1948, M=7.1).

The region of studied earthquakes are in 35.7-36.5 and 136.1-136.6 with depth 0-30 km, and the number of the earthquakes is 1446 earthquakes.
