

**Earth School: Field Seminar for Parents and Children; 5. Gets fossil and Mineral at downtown, Nagoya!**

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Earth School, a field seminar for parents and children, is operated by the Nagoya University Museum and Nagoya City Science Museum. This work is supported by Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST). It is a noteworthy example of cooperation between a university and a local museum. Earth School has been carried out 9 times in 2006: 8 times for general people, and once for curators of science museums. Each event except for event with lodging is composed of two days: one day is for learning/experiment in laboratory and the other is for fieldwork. Here we will describe the outline of 'The 8th Earth School; Get fossil and Mineral at downtown, Nagoya!' and discuss problems to be solved.
