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Cosmogenic nuclides as a powerful tool to correlate among different paleoclimatic archives

Cosmogenic nuclides in the earth are principally produced in the atmosphere by the spallation reaction between cosmic ray particles and atoms in the air. They are considered to be a powerful tool to correlate among different paleoclimatic archives.
