Web contens for schools in MeSO-net; Metropolitan Seismic Observation network

We have started a new project, the Special Project for Earthquake Disaster Mitigation in the Metropolitan Tokyo area. The core item of this project is the dense seismic array observation in metropolitan area, which is called the MeSO-net (Metropolitan Seismic Observation network). The MeSO-net consists of 400 stations and are installed mainly in an elementary school and a junior high school. In order to cooperate with school, we have started maintaining Web site that contains various information such as event waveform, temperature, atmospheric pressure data and earthquake early waring deployed by JMA.
