Questionnaire Survey of the preparation of geological information database at local governments

There are many geological information data such as bore hole data, etc. held by the local governments, and they become valuable under structure data on studying earthquake disaster prevention, etc. But we did not know how such data are assembled in each local governments. An questionnaire investigation about the preparation of the database was carried out for the local governments. About 40% of local governments in Japan were answered. A quarter of the answers says the data were arranged by the organization, but other data are not arranged. Many answers say that the necessity of arrange of the data and usefulness of mutual utilization of the digitized data, but many local governments cannot begin preparing the database for various reasons. We will proceed supporting the preparation of the database of the local governments.
