The Seismological Society of Japan and the Volcanological Society of Japan have been hosting a SchoolChildren's Summers School on Earthquake and Volcano in various locations related to earthquakes and volcanoes throughout Japan almost every year since 1999, which so far has been attended by a total of 400 children from ages 10 to 18.

It is designed for experts on the frontlines of research and practice to have opportunities to communicate directly with children regarding the mechanisms and true nature of earthquakes and volcanoes together with the blessings of nature that are inseparably related to disasters.

The course consists of games, experiments and communication that arouse children's curiosity.
