On the evacuation Public attitudes to the 2010 Chili Tsunami attack, overviewed from questionnaires analysis.

The authors report the result of the questionnaire survey conducted after the onset of Chile earthquake in the 27th and the 28th of February, 2010. Due to the Tsunami warning alert issued by the Japan Metrological Agency, more than 490,000 inhabitants were required to evacuate to the evacuate centers.

The survey was done to explore the behaviors and attitudes towards this situation in cooperation with Kamaishi city, Iwate prefecture, and Hachinohe city, Aomori prefecture.

In this presentation, the authors would discuss the attitude-behavior relationship as to the evacuation behavior.
