## New evidences of historical fissure eruptions in the Heian Period on the eastern flank of Fuji volcano, Japan

We restudied the ejecta on the eastern flank of Fuji volcano and revealed that the most ejecta erupted during recent 2,000 years. And, these ejecta conclude unrecognized three historical products in the Heian Period; these are Subashiri-Umagaeshi 5 scoria (AD790 to AD838), Subashiri-Umagaeshi 6 scoria (AD838 to AD980) and Subasiri 2 lava flow (AD980 to AD1040).
