## The study on the foraging rivers of water bird cormorant nesting Yamada-Onuma, Saitama prefecture

Cormorant is known to collect fishes from rivers and to carry them to the nests. The foraging rivers were suggested by the relationships among strontium isotope ratios (87Sr/86Sr) of the river water, fish bones collected at the cormorant nests and the cormorant bones.
