This science cafe program is a part of the project of "Legal Decision-making under Scientific Uncertainty".

[background]

In the age of science and technology (S&T), conflict concerning S&T is increasing. Such a conflict is sometimes brought into a court. However, there are several difficulties in dealing with these conflicts in courts presently, because of the lack of collaborative relationship between the two fields of specialists, lawyers and scientists. This project aims at clarification of the difficulty in the collaborative relationship and at developing a system to deal with scientific cases more effectively and fairly, especially in the case where scientific uncertainty is crucial.

The first theme is "Philosophy cafe for law and science; confliction of rationality". Mr. Kamemoto introduced the logic on the law, and Murakami did that on the science.
