The role of cultural geosites in promoting geodiversity to visitors

Geosites are attractive geotourist destinations and play important role in increasing knowledge about geology of the area where are located. They can be seen from different perspectives including possible impact on bioecological or anthropic environment. From a cultural point of view, the geodiversity can strongly influence the cultural identity of places, including ancient settlements of cities, spiritual or religious aspects, specific artistic expression (such as painting, literature and poetry, music, photography, etc).
